ATTENDANCE MATTERS!



Excellent attendance at school is important to allow a child or young person to fulfill their potential.

Here at Park, we recognise that punctual and regular attendance, alongside high standards of behaviour, is an essential prerequisite to effective learning and therefore, we are committed to maintaining high levels of attendance, punctuality and positive behaviour.

90% may seem like an acceptable level of attendance, but the reality is that 90% attendance means that your child will miss half a school day each week or 19 days of school during the school year – that's nearly 4 school weeks.

We know that there are many reasons why a student may be absent and there are times when it can be challenging to maintain a high level of attendance. On pages 3 and 4 of the newsletter we take a closer look at how we can all work together to provide the best possible start for the pupils of Park School.

HOW PORENTS AND CORERS CAN HELP IMPROVE ATTENDANCE...

Establish a good routine in the mornings and evenings so your child is prepared for the school day ahead.



Ensure your child arrives at school on time - not late.



Arrange dental and medical appointments outside school hours where possible.



Always inform the school if your child is absent due to illness.

Take family holidays outside of term time.

Talk to your child about their day at school and take an interest in their school work (including homework).



Attend parent evenings and school events when possible.

Praise and reward your child's achievements at school.



Discuss any problems or difficulties with the school – staff are there to help and will be supportive.
